The Roles

For the Childrens roles (excluding Charlie Bucket) we are looking for adults who can convincingly embody childlike characters. These roles require both strong acting and a youthful appearance

German: Mrs Gloop & Augustus

Russian: Mr Salt & Veruca

American: Mr/Mrs Beauregard & Violet, Mrs.Teavee & Mike

WILLY WONKA – Male Vocal Range: Baritone/Tenor Playing age 40+

The sly, charming, eternally youthful star of the show; lithe, eccentric, and remarkably physical, must have the ability to be filled with boundless energy and be physically light on his feet, has a larger-than-life persona that can go from charming and comical, to magically mysterious and dark.

CHARLIE BUCKET - Male Vocal Range: Unbroken Voice Playing age 8 - 12

Sweet, smart, hopeful, and loving, a boy with wonderful innocence and vulnerability, honest actor and an excellent singer with a naturally innocent voice quality.

GRANDPA JOE - Male Playing age 60+

Slight of build, frail looking but nimble, Impish, remarkably physical (dance skills a plus). He is Charlie's imaginative, fun, kind, and loving grandfather. After many years being confined to a bed, his childish energy returns when Charlie finds the Golden Ticket. Small singing role, but the singing is secondary to the actor's solid acting skills.

MRS. BUCKET – Female Playing age 30+

Charlie's warm and kind-hearted mother; a worrier, generous and loving, great dancer, a distinctive pop/folk voice.

AUGUSTUS GLOOP – Male Adult who can convincingly embody childlike characteristics and physicality

Short, youthful, round, and full faced, but wildly over-active despite his size, excellent singer and comic actor.

MRS. GLOOP – Female Vocal Range: Mezzo G3-D5 Playing age 40+

Augustus's moronic, Wagnerian mother, a huge presence with a huge voice, mirthlessly smiles as though it were affixed to the front of her face, fantastic singer and comedienne.

VERUCA SALT – Female Adult who can convincingly embody childlike characteristics and physicality

Short, youthful, vicious and beautiful, must be an excellent dancer and/or gymnast, able to dance classical ballet and modern. Comic actress with a character singing/screaming voice, Pointe shoes will be required.

MR. SALT – Male Vocal Range: Baritone Playing age 40+

Veruca's eccentric, distracted, hilarious father, finds it impossible to say no, giving in to every ridiculous demand his daughter makes. Excellent comic actor.

VIOLET BEAUREGARD – Female Adult who can convincingly embody childlike characteristics and physicality

Short, youthful, while she's physically tiny, she has a huge pop/R&B voice, as well as amazing hip-hop dance skills. Confident, forward, and full of attitude.

MR OR MRS BEAUREGARD – Male/Female, playing aged 40+

Violet's ineffectual father/mother ignores their back-talking, insult hurling daughter. A great dancer with a soul/pop/R&B voice, beat-boxing skills a plus.

MIKE TEAVEE – Male Adult who can convincingly embody childlike characteristics and physicality

Short, youthful, a firecracker with a ridiculous amount of energy, brattish, powerful, tiny, and terrifying, a voice that cuts through steel, great singer.

MRS. TEAVEE – Female Playing age 40+

She needs amphetamines to get through the day and deal with her outrageous son. Tense, extreme, and hilarious and a great singer.

SUPPORTING ROLES – Adult

Character descriptions can be found on page 7. Please be prepared to read for one of these characters if asked by the audition panel.

ENSEMBLE – Adult

An exuberant mix of characters. We will also be looking for 6 strong dancers who will take on the brunt of the choreography including all of the Oompa-Loompa-led numbers. Strong vocals.

ENSEMBLE – Child Oompa-Loompas

High energy, fun, and full of personality. Strong dancers and confident singers. May also be used in other ensemble scenes.

Audition

Who we are looking for

- The Kings Theatre is committed to ensuring that casting reflects the diversity of our community and we are looking for performers from all backgrounds, genders, and ethnicities.
- Adults are aged 18+ on audition day.
- Only children aged 9-15 will be seen (must be 9 by audition day, no older than 15 on 13th October).

Registration

- The closing date for compulsory audition registration is **end of day, Sunday 14th April**.
- The Kings Theatre reserves the right to close applications early if audition numbers exceed available audition spaces.
- You must register via the Kings website. No other way of registering will be accepted.
- You will then be contacted with details of the venue and time for auditions.
- Parent/Guardians: If you have more than one child auditioning, please fill out a separate form for each child.

Audition day information

- Auditions will be on Sunday 28th April 2024.
- On the day you will be informed if you have been recalled.
- Please note anyone who arrives late will not be able to join the audition as this will disrupt the other auditionees.
- Please be prepared to stay all day as recalls will be held for those selected from the first round of auditions. If this is the case, you will be informed of what time to return for the recall.
- The audition panel will be:
 - Paul Woolf, Producer;
 - Jack Edwards, Director;
 - Andrew Wood, Musical Director;
 - Jacqueline Willis, Choreographer;
- Taking photos or videos during the audition process is not permitted.
- By auditioning you are giving consent for photos and videos captured by The Kings Theatre on the day, to be used for promotional purposes.

What to expect on Audition Day

Audition, Round One:

- For the first round you will be taught a piece of choreography during the session which you will be asked to perform.
- If you are successful in this first round you will be asked to attend a recall later in the day.

Audition, Recall (Adults only, children please see Children's Info on the next page):

- Below on pages 5-7, along with character descriptions, you will be able to access the links to the sides, sheet music and tracks for individual roles as well as ensemble.
- Please be prepared to perform these in front of the Panel if you are recalled.





Children's Info

As well as the principal role of Charlie Bucket, we will be looking for a child ensemble to perform as Oompa-Loompas. This will primarily be dancing so individuals will be required to be able to dance to a high standard and pick up routines quickly. They may also be used in other ensemble scenes.

Please note that all children selected MUST be available for all rehearsal dates and all assigned shows. This means that some dates will require time off school. By applying to audition, you as parent/guardian agree to this.

Please note the evening shows will end at around 9.30pm.

Non-attendance at rehearsals without the prior agreement of the Production Team will result in your child being withdrawn from the show. Agreement for absence will only be given in exceptional circumstances with evidence of the emergency provided. The Producer's decision on this will be final.

Licensed chaperones will be appointed for rehearsals and the performances. If any parent/guardian who has a child performing would be interested in volunteering to become a licensed chaperone, details of how to apply for a license can be found on the relevant council websites.

Who we are looking for

- The Production Team will be casting two teams of children. The teams will perform in rotation over the 9 performances. Teams will be assigned show dates after the audition.

Audition day information

- Parents/Guardians will drop off their children and return at the collection time. You will then be informed if your child has been recalled.
- Please be prepared to be available all day as recalls will be held for those selected from the first round of auditions. If this is the case, you will be informed of what time to return for the recall.
- If your child is selected, you will have to provide all the information required for licensing within a week of accepting.
- The Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) and Head Chaperone will be Rebecca Henderson.

What to expect on Audition Day

We are looking for performers! So, encourage your child to smile and perform.

Audition, Round one:

- For the first-round children will learn a dance on the day and be asked to perform it.
- Children should come in dance wear or clothes they can move freely in. Dance footwear (or appropriate enclosed footwear) must be worn, no bare feet, Crocs or Uggs.
- Please only arrive at the registration time you are requested as there is not a holding space should people arrive early.

Audition, Recall:

- Recall times will be given, again please only arrive at your allotted time.
- Please ensure your child is ready to perform to their best ability, vocally, physically and acting-wise for the Panel.
- During this stage, parents may be required to remain on site as cuts may be made throughout this session.

Audition, Recall (Charlie's only):

- Recall times will be given, again please only arrive at your allotted time.
- Below on page 5, along with the character description, you will be able to access the links to the sides, sheet music and tracks for Charlie.
- Please ensure your child is prepared to perform these in front of the Panel if they are recalled.
- During this stage, parents may be required to remain on site as cuts may be made throughout this session.
- On application you will have confirmed if your child wishes to be seen for the Ensemble if not successful for Charlie. Please note if this is the case you won't necessarily be notified if/when they are unsuccessful for the role of Charlie but still being considered for the Ensemble.

Please remind your child if they are not successful this time, not to be upset or demotivated as there will always be other opportunities. We at The Kings will also reassure them.

SYNOPSIS OF THE STORY

Act One

Suddenly before us stands Willy Wonka, the world-renowned candy maker and inventor of the Everlasting Gobstopper, ("The Candy Man"), a genius who believes he is a forgotten man. Wonka transforms himself into the world-weary owner of a candy shop who makes the acquaintance of young Charlie Bucket, who idolizes Willy Wonka. When the shop owner tells Charlie that Wonka is about to make a comeback, the boy is thrilled but exasperated that the shop owner does not seem to know just who Willy Wonka is, ("Willy Wonka! Willy Wonka!"). Charlie comes from a poor, fatherless family that scrounges for food, and he lives for his birthday each year when he receives as a gift a single Willy Wonka Chocolate Bar. The shop owner tells him that Willy Wonka is going to open the mysteries of his chocolate factory - but only to the five lucky possessors of a golden ticket to be found in a Wonka Bar. Back home, Charlie learns that times are so hard for his family that he will not get his birthday Wonka Bar this year - so no chance at the golden ticket. Of the four eccentric grandparents who live in the house - in fact, in the same bad - Grandpa Joe is Charlie's kindred spirit, ("Charlie, You & I"), urging him on. Charlie decides to write a letter to Willy Wonka, ("A Letter from Charlie Bucket"), in which he expresses his wonder and admiration, as well as some ideas for the candy maker.

The news break that the first winner of a golden ticket is a food-loving German boy, ("More of Him to Love"), adored by his mother and named Augustus Gloop. The second, ("When Veruca Says"), is Veruca Salt, the spoiled-rotten daughter of a Russian oligarch. The winner of the third ticket, ("The Queen of Pop"), is Violet Beauregarde, whose publicity hound of a father is turning her pursuit of a world record for chewing gum into a media event. The fourth ticket, ("What Could Possibly Go Wrong?"), goes to Mike Teavee, a brat who is mesmerized by social media, to the delight of his mother. Charlie appears to be out of luck, leaving his mother and grandparents wistful for what she is unable to provide, ("If Your Father Were Here"), when fate intervenes. He finds some money on the ground and buys a Wonka bar from Mrs. Green's cart and discovers a golden ticket, making him the fifth winner. Charlie and his whole family celebrate the news, ("I've Got a Golden Ticket" / "Grandpa Joe"), that he is headed to Willy Wonka's Chocolate Factory, where Grandpa Joe will join him. At long last, Willy Wonka welcomes the winners into his factory, teasing them about what lies ahead for them, ("It Must Be Believed to Be Seen").

Act Two

Inside the factory, Wonka introduces the winners to the wonders they are about to encounter - and some things they need to remember, ("Strike That, Reverse It"). Charlie and Grandpa Joe are in awe of Wonka and what the magical experience has to offer, ("Pure Imagination" / "Grandpa Joe (Reprise)"), while the other children are greedy and impatient. One by one, the ticket holders become victims of their own appetites. Augustus Gloop's insatiable hunger for the chocolate waterfall makes him the first victim, ("The Oompa-Loompa Song" / "Auf Wiedersehen Augustus Gloop"), his fate determined by the mysterious Oompa-Loompas who do Wonka's bidding. Wonka explains to his guests how he freed the Oompa-Loompas and they became his allies, ("When Willy Met Oompa"). His warnings fall on deaf ears. Violet is then the next golden ticket holder to vanish followed by Veruca, ("Veruca's Nutcracker Sweet"), and finally Mike Teavee ("Vidiots"). Ultimately, there is only Charlie, in whom Willy Wonka sees an heir to his magical mission. He welcomes Charlie into a magical glass elevator that takes them up, up, up, so the boy can see everything that will be his, ("The View from Here"), a happy home and limitless future, thanks to the Candy Man.

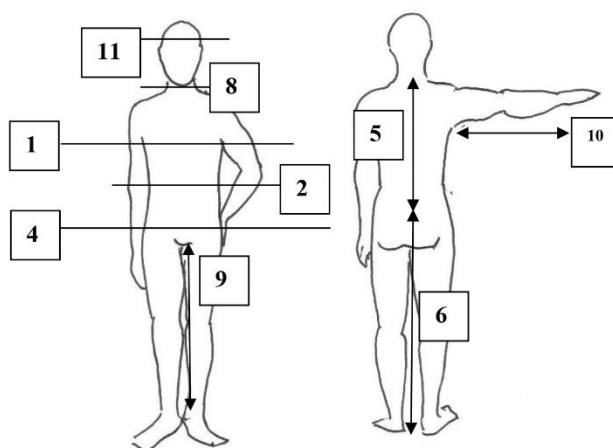

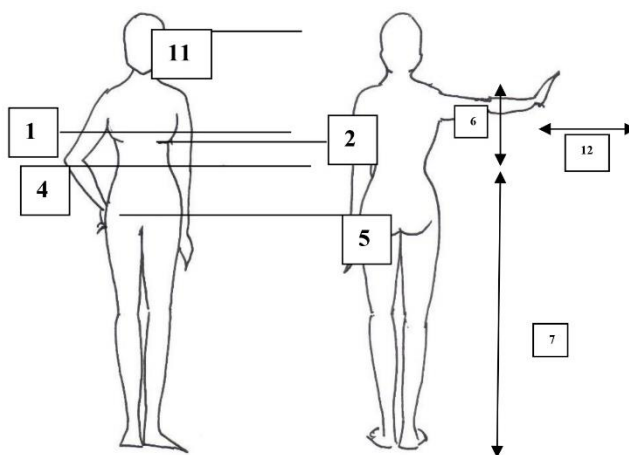
