Welcome to MCO - the HAPPIEST BASE ON **EARTH!** Southwest Airlines began service to Orlando International Airport in 1996, offering 12 daily non-stop departures. Demand continued to increase and in 2001, the Inflight Crew Base was opened with about 200 pilots and 350 Flight Attendants. Today, MCO is home to 1200+ Flight Attendants, and offers nonstop service to 51 different markets... including Montego Bay, Jamaica! MCO also has a "sister" base in FLL, which opened as one of SWAs first

Satellite Bases in 2017.

Southwest Airlines operates out of Terminal A, utilizing Gates 101-110 and 120-129.

### Known Crew Member (KCM)


If you are facing the TSA Checkpoint, go to the left (towards the exit by Starbucks) and you will see the KCM sign guiding you to the entrance.

#### **KCM TIPS:**

- KCM can be used by Crew Members, whether they are working or traveling for pleasure (DOMESTIC ONLY!).
- You can go through KCM out of uniform, but remember that you will

need 3 forms of valid ID. Also, if you are selected for additional screening, you will be subject to the TSA liquid restrictions.

## **Inflight Crew Lounge Information**

The MCO Inflight Lounge is located below Gate 120. The elevator is located adjacent to Starbucks, next to the InMotion store. Once inside the elevator, enter the access code found in your IEFB and select the 1st floor. When you get off the elevator, turn right

and the lounge will be at the end of the hall. Wave your SWA ID to gain entry.

#### \*\*\* IMPORTANT \*\*\*

Our lounge is a SIDA secured location. Your SWA ID

MUST be displayed at waist level or above at all times while in the secured areas. If you

have a family member you'd like to bring to the lounge, please call the Base to have them escorted. When returning to the terminal via the elevator, it is mandatory to enter the access code and select the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

# TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANIES (RIDESHARE)

Lyft, Uber and Wingz pick up at Terminal A and B at the ends of the arrivals curb (Level 2). All ridesharing services drop off at the MCO Airport at the Level 3 Departures curb for Terminal A and B.

#### LYNX (BUS)

The Lynx public bus system can be found in Terminal A on Level 1 (Ground Transportation), spaces

A38-A41. Cost is \$2 for each destination. Connecting service to shopping and residential areas is also available.

#### **SUNRAIL (TRAIN)**

The SunRail commuter train system currently offers quick and efficient transportation over 49 miles with 16 stations. Dependent on where you are travelling, tickets range from \$2 - 5 one way.
