Frequently Asked Questions

P Is there parking near the Cleveland terminal?
Yes, there is free council parking available on the opposite side of the road to our terminal and along Middle Street.

B Is there a bus that connects train & the ferry?
Yes, there is a TransLink bus (Route 258) that can take you from the Cleveland train station to our ferry terminal. You can check timetables and prices on the [Translink Journey Planner](#).

B Is there a public bus on the island?
The SeaLink Passenger Ferry departs from the second ferry terminal on the bus route from Point Lookout. The public bus leaves Point Lookout 35 mins prior to the passenger ferry departure.

Can I take my dog/pets with me?
Yes, dogs are allowed on-board the ferry and public bus on the island, however, they must wear a lead and muzzle. Dogs should be clean and dry, and not sitting on a seat. All other pets must be in a pet carrier or crate.

Are Student or Concession tickets available?
You can purchase a Student or Concession ticket, however you will need to show a valid card when travelling. If you cannot present a valid card, you will have to pay the difference in fare.
